ABOUT US :

Sea Trust Wales is a marine wildlife conservation charity based in Pembrokeshire. Our mission is to get local people taking care of their marine wildlife by conducting scientific research, raising awareness of marine conservation issues, educating the public and contributing to the conservation of the marine environment.

RESEARCH

Interns will assist with all of our research projects including: Porpoise and grey seal photo-ID, cetacean surveys, Recycle Môr. Tasks include collecting, entering, analysing and reporting scientific data. Processing photos and updating ID catalogues. Collecting and recycling End of Life fishing waste. Perform land based survey with opportunities for boat based work.

AQUARIUM

Sea Trust have a small catch and release aquarium. This is open to the public and we provide guided tours. Interns will assist with the aquarium maintenance (feeding, tank maintenance, releasing species and collecting new species and general cleaning). Interns will also assist with the guided tours which would be a great way of improving communication skills.

EDUCATION & OUTREACH

Sea Trust provides marine based educational activities for school groups and community groups. We also run a weekly Marine Biology club for 10-16 year olds. Interns will assist with these activities as well as planning sessions. Sea Trust spread their research and conservation messages through several ways including social media, talks presentations and our visitor centre. Interns will help raise awareness of the charity and its work.
